



COURSE OUTLINE

AIM

The course is aimed at first response, middle and senior level silver incident commanders who will command operations at incidents involving firework storage facilities.

OBJECTIVE

At the end of the course the learner will be able to:

1. List the United Nations explosion hazard divisions and types.
2. Identify the hazards involved in ISO container storage of fireworks.
3. Understand the effects of exposure of personnel or the general public to explosive blast.
4. Identify the key control measures contained within Fire Service Generic Risk Assessment 5.7 Explosives (Version 2), including the establishment of hazard exclusion zones.
5. Produce a tactical plan to resolve the incident safely with keeping with the high level of hazard and risk involved.
6. Generate tactical solutions to respond to an incident according to the different storage capacities of premises and actual and anticipated problems as the incident progresses.
7. Liaise with other services to identify all relevant issues and generate combined solutions including the management of exclusion zones and deployment of joint resources.

DESCRIPTION

The course will consist of one day's teaching and practical scenario held at your training centre or a local venue.

Learners will receive taught input from a qualified tutor including a relevant case study and undertake practical scenario simulation.

The practical scenario can be conducted using your in house simulator (Vector, Minerva). Digital Combustion software (Fire Studio 4) will be used as standard and can be tailored for a specific relevant risk in your service area.

An online community of practice with discussion forum and chat room will be available to support learners after the course ends.
