COURSE OUTLINE

AIM:

The course is aimed at station managers who will undertake the BA Main Control officer role at an operational incident.

OBJECTIVE:

At the end of the course the delegate will be able to:-

1. Assume responsibility for BA support operations as the incident moves from Stage II to Main Control.
2. Set up the BA support unit.
3. Arrange for sufficient cylinders and sets to be available for deployment.
4. Set up a staging area for BA wearers.
5. Keep accurate records of movement into and out of the inner cordon.

- Practical scenario assessment can be conducted using your in house simulator (Vector, Minerva) or command support unit.
- Digital Combustion or similar software will be used if you wish to tailor the scenarios to specific risks in your service.
