COURSE OUTLINE

AIM:

The course is aimed at fire service principle officers and area managers who are competent to command operational incidents involving more than ten appliances but require an opportunity to refresh their skills.

OBJECTIVE:

At the end of the course the learner will:

1. Collect information through observation and consultation with the L3 incident commander, draw conclusions and agree further action to progress the resolution of the incident.
2. Produce a level 4 tactical plan to resolve the incident, taking account of all influencing factors and complexity of the situation at this level including the increased level of hazard and risk.
3. Generate solutions to meet segmented problems as the incident progresses.
4. Conduct inter-agency liaison with other services to identify all relevant issues and generate combined solutions including redeployment of joint resources.
5. Provide support and direction to the operations commander and support officers.
6. Conduct a comprehensive transfer briefing with the oncoming L3 or L4 incident commander.
7. Identify the differences between the 2nd and 3rd edition Fire Service Incident Command Manual.

DESCRIPTION:

- The course will consist of one days teaching and assessment held at your training centre or a local venue.
- Learners will undertake an initial assessment, taught input from a qualified tutor and practical scenario simulation.
- Learners will produce a portfolio of video and hard copy evidence of competence over the day.
- Practical scenario assessment can be conducted using your in house simulator (Vector, Minerva). Digital Combustion or similar software will be used if you wish to tailor the scenarios to specific risks in your service.
- An online community of practice with discussion forum and chat room will be available to support learners after the course ends.
