COURSE OUTLINE

AIM:

The course is aimed at watch or station managers who will command a water sector at an operational incident.

OBJECTIVE:

At the end of the course the delegate will be able to:-

1. Plan, resource and conduct a water sector at a large incident.
2. Undertake an assessment of water requirements for an operational incident using the IOWA and number of jets methodologies.
3. Select an appropriate water strategy using water carrying or water relay.
4. Estimate the frictional loss in Porter and Hi volume hose water relays
5. Complete a water survey and recommend an appropriate water strategy to the Incident Commander.
6. Implement the water management strategy as directed.
